NEWSLETTER – AUTUMN 2021

Well here we are....Autumn again, Summer and the included 'silly season' seemed to pass quickly and already we are at the beginning of March ! Time flies and with the Covid 19 vaccine currently being distributed around the country it may take a while to get full coverage and for things to go 100% back to the way things used to be but we are certainly on the way towards normality again.

Here at Tiffin Motorhomes Australia we have seen unprecedented demand for the MY21 Allegro Breeze 33IBR motorhome. Buyers used to experiencing the finer things in life have been snapping our motorhomes up before they have even been built. In order to cope with the increase in demand we have improved and refined many of our 'final finish' processes here and the experience that is being gained by every one of our team members on a daily basis is showing in the stunning final product that we are proudly handing over to our customers.

The first Allegro Breeze 33IBR with the new MY21 'Dior' décor package was handed over to its lucky owner just two weeks ago, and it looked stunning, this model also was fitted with a residential size washer / dryer 'combo' machine in a new location – in the wardrobe and we must agree that this was a great idea by Tiffin USA, freeing up even more room in the basement for storage and allowing the luxury of being able to wash and dry the laundry in the comfort of the motorhome rather than outside in the weather as before. The wardrobe also benefits now from an increase in size so the space taken up has not affected the hanging space at all. The MY21 Allegro Breeze 33IBR is now fitted with revised front seats, still with the same functionality, but even more comfortable than before (if that was even possible !), the revised digital instrument cluster with the incorporated controls for the air suspension levelling system and tyre pressure monitoring have taken tech in the cockpit to the next level. Electronic Stability Control is also a great safety addition.

Probably some of the biggest news to happen over Summer is that we have now finalised the R&D on our brand new optional power upgrade packages, all with Lithium battery power to suit different price points and purposes. The Ultimate power upgrade package includes a Lithium battery bank with a whopping 800A/h of power charged by 1,800 watts of solar power and running through two 3,000 watt invertors. This has been designed to provide an abundance of power in an 'off grid' situation with enough grunt to power air conditioners, water heater and appliances for long periods of time.

If you are the type of traveller that would rather do your own thing and stay away from Caravan Parks etc, one of these optional new power packages combined with the option of an additional water tank giving a total of about 430lts of capacity and an optional extra gas bottle giving a total of 27kg of gas, should see most bases covered. Wherever possible we try to install 'energy efficient' appliances to our motorhomes, even in base specification, the two roof mounted air conditioners and the residential refrigerator use 'invertor' technology which is a huge improvement on the types of appliances other motorhomes are fitted with. Water in the 23lt storage tank can be heated with either gas or 240V power, the heating in the motorhome can either be via the reverse cycle ducted air conditioning system or the onboard gas furnace requiring no external power input. The MY21 Tiffin Allegro Breeze 33IBR really has all of the bases covered and is the only motorhome on the Australian market that has been entirely 'built from scratch' – including the Tiffin made 'Powerglide' chassis, with the whole purpose being for life as a luxury motorhome.

Digital Instrument Cluster – NEW Features ...

Operated via the rotary dial within easy reach of the drivers RH hand, the fully digital instrument cluster now is able to display an 'on board' tyre pressure monitoring system able to switch between tyre pressures and temperatures so you always know what is going on. Turn the dial again and the suspension controls come in to view, easy 'one touch' operation of 'Travel', 'High Ride', 'Low Ride' and Auto levelling, for more complex tasks, manual operation allows full control of whatever you want the motorhomes suspension to do !

Power Upgrade Options – NEW Lithium Packages coming soon ...

In order to be more 'off grid' friendly, three new power upgrades are being introduced shortly – ALL Lithium options, 400A/h, 600A/h AND 800A/h, designed to be able to run air conditioners, microwave ovens and water heaters without the necessity to plug in to shore power or start the generator. Lithium batteries maintain a consistent voltage through their entire capacity allowing you to use 100% of the power available with quick Solar recovery / recharge time for off grid use days on end ! With long warranties and 1000's of cycles available, these new system truly are the way of the future .

Residential Washer / Dryer 'Combo' – Option

NEW Wardrobe Design ... 'Laundry is a Breeze'

The wardrobe in the master bedroom has been re-designed, it is now wider, and deeper than before in order to be able to incorporate the fitment of a residential sized 7.5kg washer / 4.5kg dryer 'combo' or just a washing machine on the RH side. No space has been lost as the extra depth gained now on the LH side allows additional hanging space. Fitting this here means that the laundry can be done in 'all weathers' in the comfort of your coach, also freeing up the previously used space in the basement. The residential size means that sheets and large items can also be washed with ease !



43in Smart TV & Residential Fridge with wine rack (option)

TV & Refrigerator ...

We have upgraded the size of the lounge area TV to 43in, it is a smart TV so connecting it to a mobile data device and watching Netflix or Youtube is no issue.

The residential fridge by Samsung is powered by Digital Inverter Technology and has been tested to draw even less current than a standard 12V RV fridge, now you have 270lt of refrigerated storage capacity with a stunning brushed stainless steel finish to complement the interior of your coach

For the wine lovers, the optional 7 bottle wine rack is a great choice to keep those treasured bottles on hand for easy access.

NEW Galley Counter Top & Interior Décor Package ...

The previous Solafine Décor package has been superseded by the brand new 'Dior' Décor package, consisting of the stunning 'Volare' counter tops, much lighter in colour and with a slight glint of a metallic 'fleck' feature throughout, the whole mood in the motorhome has lifted. The new matching splashback is very complimentary as are the extras such as cushions and bed coverings.

The cooktop has now been recessed with a removeable cover matching the countertop in place. The double bowl sink also has matching covers. The whole counter top can now be a workspace. Under the standard fitment cooktop and grill is a great sized 'pot drawer' however this can be removed and the option of either a gas fan forced full oven or a single drawer dishwasher can be selected.

For those who like a bit of ambience, under counter strip lighting (optional) can be fitted to the galley and bedroom counters and wired to come on with the standard accent lighting, additional strip lighting can also be fitted to the entry stairs and under the medicine cabinet in the bathroom.

Macerator toilets, bedside fans, extra power points for electric blankets or CPAP machines, Roof mounted Wi-Fi antenna's, UHF radios, GPS Navigation, GPS Tracking systems etc etc can also be optionally added in to the 'final build'.

Customising a new Tiffin motorhome to suit your needs perfectly is what this is all about.
